

TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURES - BARANGAROO AND MILLERS POINT

HICKSON ROAD TEMPORARY NIGHT CLOSURES

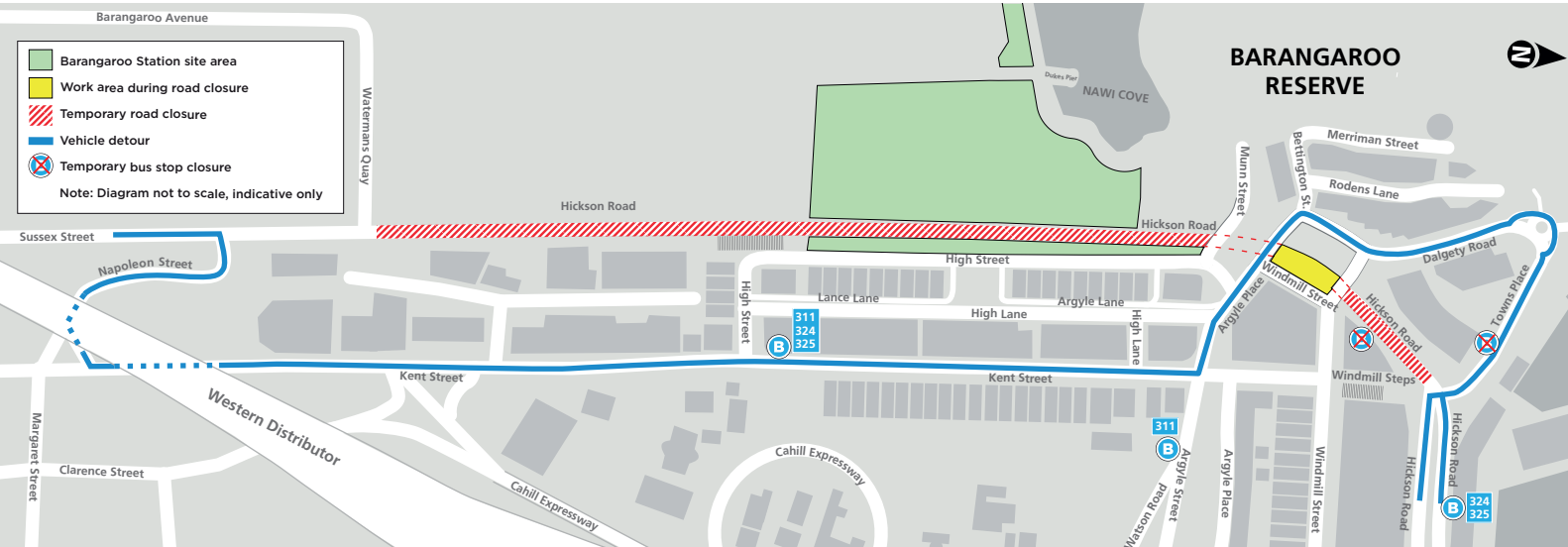
Hickson Road will be closed between Towns Place and Watermans Quay for two nights to allow for construction of a temporary acoustic shed:

- ▶ **10pm Thursday 26 April to 5am Friday 27 April 2018**
- ▶ **10pm Friday 27 April to 5am Saturday 28 April 2018**

A detour will be in place via Dalgety Road, Kent Street and Napoleon Street. Bus services 311, 324 and 325 will be rerouted via this detour. The 311 bus stops at Towns Place and Hickson Road will

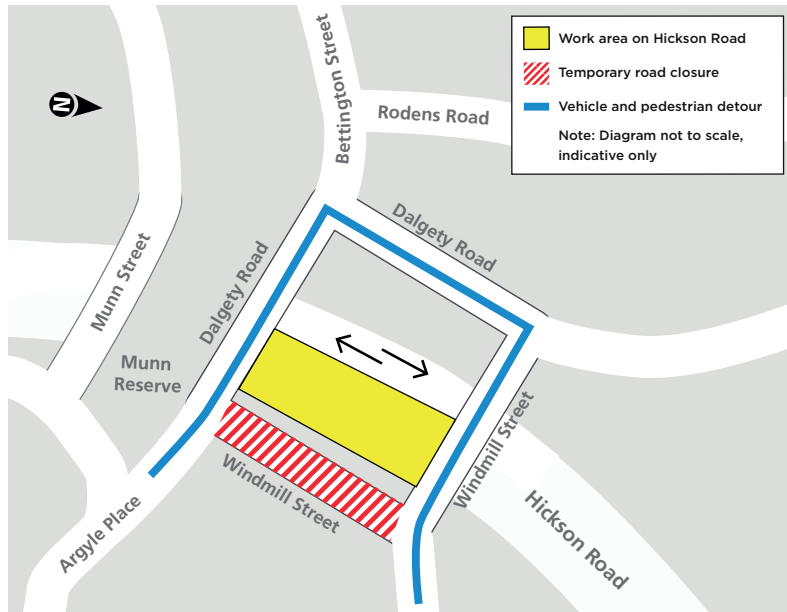
be temporarily closed and commuters should use the bus stop at the corner of Argyle Street and Watson Road. The 324 and 325 bus stops will not be affected.

A temporary bus stop will be located near the corner of Kent Street and High Street. This bus stop will service the 311, 324 and 325 bus services. Access to driveways on Hickson Road will be maintained for residents and businesses only. Pedestrian access to the High Steps, Nawi Cove and Barangaroo Reserve will be maintained during the temporary road closure.



TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURES - BARANGAROO AND MILLERS POINT

Sydney Metro is Australia's biggest public transport project. Services start in 2019 in the city's North West with a train every four minutes in the peak. Metro rail will be extended into the CBD and beyond to Bankstown in 2024. Sydney Metro includes new CBD railway stations underground at Martin Place, Pitt Street and Barangaroo and new metro platforms under Central. In 2024, Sydney Metro will have 31 stations on a new 66km rail system - the biggest urban rail project in Australian history. Sydney Metro will have ultimate capacity for a train every two minutes in each direction under the CBD. John Holland CPB Ghella Joint Venture (JHCPBG) has been awarded the \$2.81 billion contract to build the twin railway tunnels from Chatswood to Sydenham and excavate six new Sydney Metro stations.



WINDMILL STREET TEMPORARY CLOSURE

From **7am Tuesday 1 May to late May 2018**, Windmill Street at Millers Point will be closed between the Windmill Street and Dalgety Road bridges to allow for construction of the temporary acoustic shed. Some parking spaces on the Windmill Street bridge will be unavailable for short periods during these works.

A detour will be in place via Dalgety Road for vehicles and pedestrians during this temporary road closure. Bus services will not be impacted during these works.

Access to driveways will be maintained for residents and businesses only.

These works are necessary as we build the new Barangaroo Station. Please observe all safety and directional signs. Thank you for your understanding and cooperation as we carry out this essential work.
